Lunch box and snack reminder



Due to children who attend St Nicolas Academy that have a severe life threatening allergy to nuts, we kindly request that you do not send your child to school with any products containing nuts for their snacks or in their packed lunch. Please could you avoid sending the following items into school; packs of nuts, peanut butter sandwiches, fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts, chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts, sesame seed roll, cakes made with nuts and Hazelnut chocolate spread.

Parking

Please can you all be considerate when parking in and around the school. Schools always have issues with parking, and abide with the rules of the Highway Code – which state that:

- Vehicle must not cause an obstruction (Private drives, junctions etc)
- Vehicle must not be parked within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction

We do accept that vehicles need to be parked partly on the footpath to avoid causing obstruction to the road at times. However, there must be room on the pavement for a double buggy or mobility scooter to pass safely. Also, please do not leave your car running whilst awaiting for your child.
