### Year 3

In D and T, Year 3 have been learning about pneumatic systems. Firstly, the children investigated uses of air in objects such as recorders, balloon pumps, party blowers and beach balls. They then investigated moving an object using air, this was with a tube, balloons and syringes. Finally the children designed a moving monster which they made from boxes and created their own pneumatic system.



### Pupil Premium

Did you know that we can help with Clubs and trips if you qualify for Pupil Premium. If you think you may be eligible, please call the School office, who will be happy to help you.

This applies if you receive any of the following benefits:

Universal credit (Provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)

Income Support.

Income-based jobseekers' allowance.

Income-related employment and support allowance.

Support under part IV of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999.

The guaranteed element of state pension credit.

Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less.

Children who are or have been in care, and children who have a parent who is or was in the armed forces, are also entitled to Pupil Premium.

In addition, pupils, who have qualified for Free School Meals on the above grounds in the past, but are no longer eligible, continue to receive Pupil Premium for the next six years. If you would like help to apply for this or would like to use the school telephone, please phone the office staff.

## Flu Vaccination - Foundation—Year 6

The North Warwickshire Immunisation team will be in school on **Wednesday 9th November 2022** to administer the Nasal Flu Vaccination to all children from Reception through to Year 6 inclusive. They have now moved to electronic consent to reduce the amount of paper work that is delivered via school. In order for your child to receive the vaccine please click on the **Unique Consent Link or QR code**. If the consent form is not completed your child will not be able to have the vaccine. **The link for our school closes at midnight on the 23rd October 2022 all consent must be completed by this date.**
