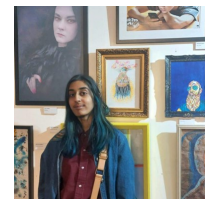

Following the great success of last year (apart from the heatwave and the rain) we will be hosting year group sports day on Thursday 13th July with the following times:

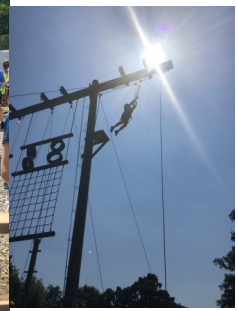
- 9.00-9.45 - Year 6

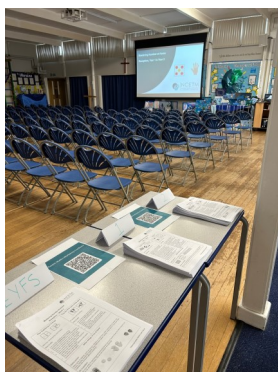
Maths
