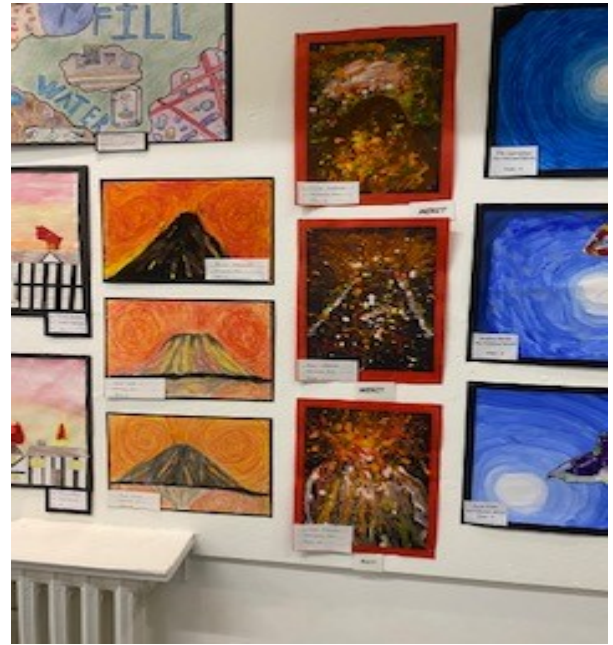
Festival of Arts
