Parents Evening will take place w/c 14th March on our School Cloud system. This will be virtual. We will send more information to you as to when you are able to book your appointment.

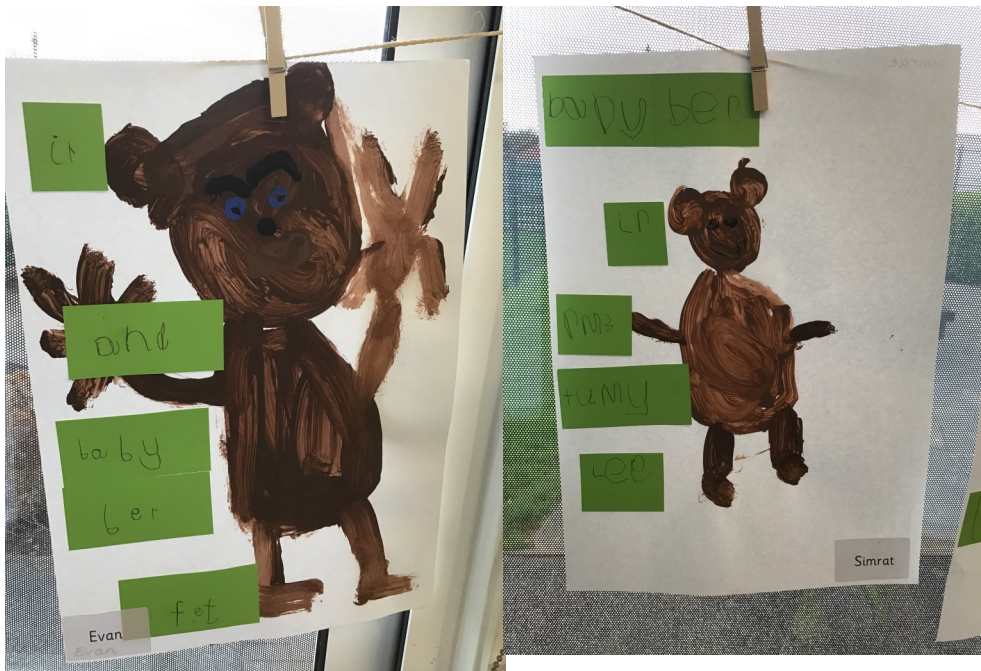

Our Aims at St Nics

Every week we have an article of the week assembly; each lesson being based on one or two different rights .

This year we would like to achieve the *Silver* award this means to know what the rights are and what they are for.

What are the rights?

In total there are **45 rights** each of them with different meanings. The rights apply to every one under 18 years old regards of where the were born their religion or who they are.

Across our school, we are focusing specifically on four rights:

Article 2: protection from discrimination

Article 12: to respect the views of a child

Article 29: goals of education

Article 31: the right to relax and play



When and who decided on the rights?

In 1989, Governments from around the world adopted the rights and the UK further ratified them in 1991. All human treaties that were created are international agreements that apply equally to children and adults.
