In some African villages, people live in huts of thatch and dried mud.

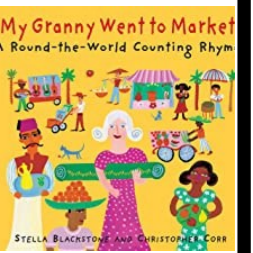
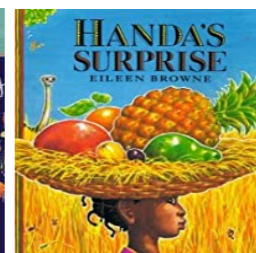
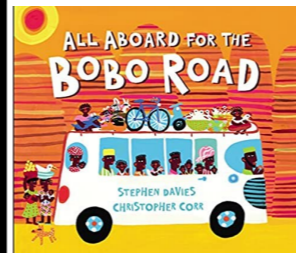
