How is our country different to other places in the world?

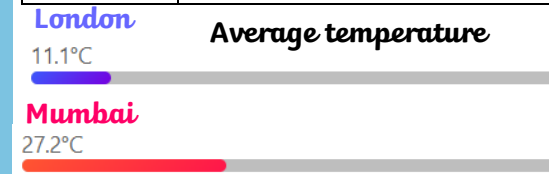
In our world we have 7 continents and 5 oceans.

The oceans are: Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Arctic Ocean, Southern



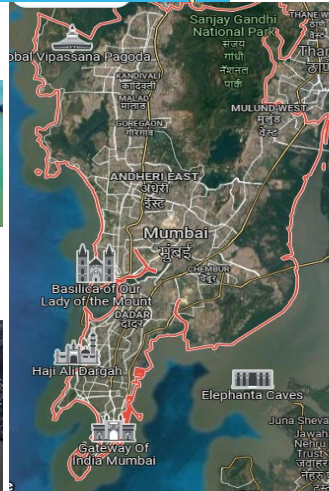

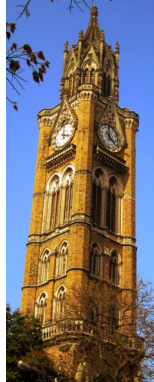
