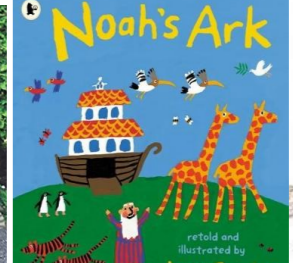
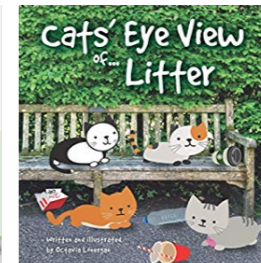
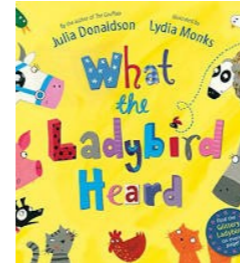
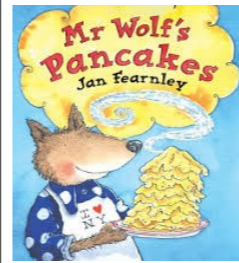
When sunshine and rain occur together it creates a rainbow.
